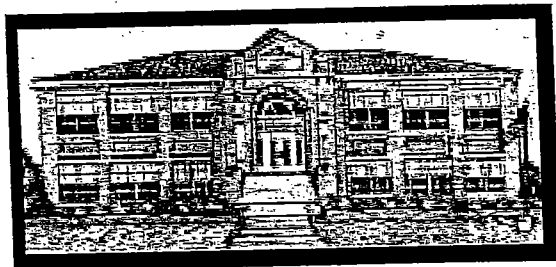

Enclosed is the stewardship form of time, talent, and treasure which is required to be submitted annually by all St. Dominic School families.

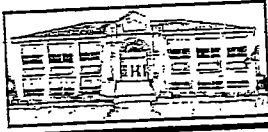

Parish Rates

In-Parish Instructional Fees + Stewardship

Parish members in good standing for at least two years pay the instructional fees below, which covers the costs of textbooks, workbooks, planners, technology expenses and costs for classroom materials and cafeteria fees. This rate does not include miscellaneous student school supplies like loose-leaf paper, notebooks, glue stick, tissues, pencils, etc.

Fees must be paid in full by March 1 and may be paid according to the schedule below. Parishioners in good standing are those who are active and faithful to St. Dominic Church and School in terms of time, talent, treasure and regular attendance at Mass. The recommended levels of giving for school families through stewardship are provided below. Completion of the annual stewardship forms for both the parish and the school is required. **Effective August 2011, all school families are required to fulfill their stewardship obligations via automatic withdrawal.** Families may choose to pay their Instructional Fees monthly via automatic bank withdrawal and include that payment with their stewardship automatic withdrawal. Please indicate this on the Parish Stewardship Treasure Form.

The average cost to educate a child at St. Dominic School for one year is around \$4000. Note that families with more than one child pay considerably less than \$4000 per child; this is made possible through the financial assistance provided by St. Dominic parish. Before making their annual tithing pledge, school families should pay careful attention to the recommended levels of giving, because the amount pledged has a direct impact on the school's annual operating budget.

Non-Parish Tuition Rates

The annual cost to educate a child at St. Dominic is around \$4000. This rate does not include PTO fees (\$30 per family) or miscellaneous class supplies like loose-leaf paper, notebooks, pencils, etc. Families with more than one child pay considerably less than \$4000 per child, thanks to the financial assistance provided by St. Dominic parish. Non-parish families are also required to complete a school stewardship form to indicate the volunteer work that they are able to do. Partial tuition scholarships are available through the Catholic Education Foundation to qualified applicants. For the 2011-2012 school year, tuition paying families can choose to pay their tuition through monthly automatic bank withdrawal.
